University of New Mexico Psychology Minor Requirements

The requirements for a Psychology Minor are described below and in the University Catalog.

To obtain a minor, students must complete eighteen (18) credit hours in Psychology with a grade of “C” or better (*grades of C- are not accepted*). **PSYC 1110 Introduction to Psychology is the only required course for the minor.** Student may select PSY courses of their choice to complete the additional 15 credit hours for the minor. *Please note some psychology courses have prerequisites.*

*****Six (6) credit hours (1/4 of the minor) MUST be taken at UNM to meet the residency requirement.*****
