

PSY 499 to Meet Major Laboratory Requirement Petition

Students have an opportunity to petition to use PSY 499 to satisfy an upper-division psychology laboratory requirement for their major. This is a special arrangement made between a student and a Psychology Faculty Sponsor.

- **Students must review the informational sheet at the beginning of the semester to familiarize themselves with the requirements and construct a plan of action with their faculty sponsor for the semester.**
- This process is not automatic.
- The student must register for at least two credit hours of PSY 499 to receive laboratory credit.
- This form is completed at the end of the semester once the student's final grade has been entered.

This should be completed no later than the week following finals week. Bring this completed form to an Undergraduate Program Advisor to begin the process to receive laboratory credit for the major.

The student is required to write an APA formatted paper covering a topic related to the faculty sponsor's research. The faculty sponsor will stipulate the length and contents of the paper.
